

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PARKING
PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (VARIOUS ROADS,
SHREWSBURY) (AMENDMENT NO. 3) ORDER 2023**

On 14 December 2023 Shropshire Council made an order to make the following changes to parking restrictions in Shrewsbury:

a) No Waiting At Any Time restrictions will be placed on:

Preston Street (north-east side)	From its junction with Abbey Foregate south-eastwards to a point 2 metres north-west of the property boundary of no. 27 and no. 29 Preston Street.
Preston Street (south-west side)	From a point adjacent to the party wall of no. 28 and no. 30 Preston Street south-eastwards to a point 2 metres north-west of the property boundary of no. 27 and 29 Preston Street.
Broughton Road (north-west side)	From its junction with Meadow Farm Drive north-eastwards for a distance of 16 metres measured from the Give Way line
Broughton Road (south-east side)	From its junction with Meadow Farm Drive north-eastwards for a distance of 10 metres measured from the Give Way line

Any existing restrictions at the above locations will be revoked.

These changes will come into effect on 16 December 2023.

A copy of the order may be examined during normal office hours (8:45am-5:00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:45am-4:00pm on Fridays) at Shropshire Council, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury SY2 6ND.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions in it, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 14 December 2023, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
