- Audit all agreements/forms Look at how can we promote climate change actions and active travel in all of our comms.
- Communicate what we are doing on a monthly basis including a regular spot of 'what can
  I do to help the climate and nature crisis' talking about the wider values of trees in our
  environment for example.

#### 5. Event

Organise week long climate change event. Focus on practical help for the community.

'Not just beavers' – potentially tie in with beaver arrivals.

ACTION: Develop a plan for climate change week.

# 6. Carbon Literacy Training
