

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(BOROUGH OF SHREWSBURY & ATCHAM) (NO. 1)
(SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2006 (AMENDMENT NO. 2) ORDER 2026**

Shropshire Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of their powers under Sections 84(1) and (2), and 82(2) of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to, the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”), and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:

1. The Shropshire Council (Borough of Shrewsbury & Atcham) (No. 1) (Speed Limits) Order 2006 is hereby amended as follows:
 - i. The following length of road in Shrewsbury is deleted from Schedule 3 (30mph Speed Limit):

Horsefair	In its entirety
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 - ii. The following lengths of roads in Shrewsbury are deleted from the Restricted Roads Schedule:

Abbey Foregate	From its junction with Whitehall Street in a westerly and then south-westerly direction for a distance of 230 metres
Railway Lane	In its entirety
Portobello	In its entirety
 - iii. The following lengths of roads in Shrewsbury are added to Schedule 2 (20mph Speed Limit):

Horsefair	In its entirety
Abbey Foregate	From its junction with Whitehall Street in a westerly and then south-westerly direction for a distance of 230 metres
Railway Lane	In its entirety
Railway Terrace	In its entirety
Portobello	In its entirety
2. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 17 August 2026 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Borough of Shrewsbury & Atcham) (No. 1) (Speed Limits) Order 2006 (Amendment No. 2) Order 2026.
