
Purpose of the Report

The Safer Streets team of Detached Youth Workers, from Shropshire Youth, held a shared supervision and planning session on Saturday 29th April at the Quarry Leisure Centre, involving:

- Media artist Arron Fowler how the work can be evaluated in a creative way and ensuring that young people's voices are heard throughout the process.
