It sets out West Mercia Polices promise to ensure a two-way conversation and continuing to engage with parish and town councils, with regular contact through written updates and engaging with communities both in person, via social media and the Neighbourhood Matters website, ensuring they were accessible to all. The Policing Priorities are collated from Councillors each quarter. These are then forwarded to the Inspector, in readiness for the next phase. WMP report back with updates on the priorities raised.
