



During March to May, Security have recovered and returned £4,177.55 worth of items.

PSPO

Continuation and expansion of the PSPO is scheduled to be discussed at Shropshire Council's cabinet on 19th July 2023, with a view to implementation from 1st August 2023.

SC Youth continue to visit Schools once per month.

Current Projects:

- Empower Her (programme for young women) a social action project.
- Positive relationships (shorter programme) will be issued in September, covering appropriate language and the effects on environment.
- Below the Belt (young males) discussing masculinity.
- Digital Resilience Programme (currently being compiled), looking at exploitation.
- Funding has been received for a Participation Worker. Individual will be working alongside Public
 Health, Housing and domestic abuse, looking into why young people become exploited and how
 services can be designed to meet there needs.
- Youth platform, detailing what is available for young people across the County. Service transformation work taking place, looking at various strategies including a participation strategy for the whole of the County.
- 'Stay Safe' document. Young people to create a 'stay safe' document to encourage other young people to stay safe.

STC Youth continues to liaise with Schools with updates on Youth sessions.

Alternative Curriculum (AC) work continues to take place.

Developing a Youth Council (encourage young people in decision making). Individuals will have the opportunity to express their views and meet their local Councillors.
