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INTRODUCTION

The engagement strategy for The Quarry Park CMP is organised into four distinct stages, tailored to optimise input into the development of the Conservation Management Plan. Each stage is different in purpose, format and outcome. These dates are indicative for present purposes.

- ROUND ZERO-Annual Town Meeting-30 April 2026
- ROUND ONE-Initial public engagement-25 May to 8 June 2026
- ROUND TWO-Targeted stakeholder engagement-28 August to 12 October 2026
- ROUND THREE-Consultation on draft CMP-9 November to 30 November 2026

The last agenda item of the Annual Town Meeting, Thursday 30 April 2026, consisted of a public workshop, as the first part of the Quarry CMP engagement, becoming ENGAGEMENT ROUND ZERO in the overall strategy set out above.

- The Annual Town Meeting is a public event held in the Guildhall at 7pm on Thursday 30 April, for STC to engage with the public and discuss ongoing initiatives. This is a great opportunity to consult the public on Quarry Park CMP.

- The purpose of the consultation is for us to find out what people think about the how The Quarry is now and what it should be like in the future. This will be very helpful as we start to develop the CMP.

- It was in a 'World Café' format with a number of tables, each covering one subject (eg safety, play, access, wildlife etc), where people can discuss (amongst themselves and with the team) and leave post-it notes with their thoughts, observations, concerns and ideas.

- The visual material was structured into the following themes, covering the wide range of issues that people are interested in, and the wide range of issues that STC will need to address in future years, as custodians of The Quarry.

- Each theme was championed by a team member, who moved around each table in turn, encouraging people to share their thoughts on each subject, discussing with the group and writing down as much as possible.

- The time available was limited to a few minutes, to retain focus and keep energy levels high.

- The eight presentation boards were displayed digitally as well as printed out for the public during the meeting and were helpful to inform the discussion.

- STC advertised as widely as possible, to maximise the number of people attending.

The purpose of this document is to record all of the input provided by members of the public, which makes a great start in establishing public priorities for the next phase of the life of The Quarry.
