TEAM SHREWSBURY – LOCAL POLICING CHARTER

Purpose of the Report

To receive an update on the Local Policing Charter. The Local Policing Charter is based on three principles: visibility, accessibility, engagement. It sets out West Mercia Polices promise to ensure a two-way conversation and continuing to engage with parish and town councils, with regular contact through written updates and engaging with communities both in person, via social media and the Neighbourhood Matters website, ensuring they were accessible to all. The Policing Priorities are collated from Councillors each quarter. These are then forwarded to the Inspector, in readiness for the next phase. WMP report back with updates on the priorities raised.

I don't have evidence for this... but the speeding is reported by many residents. These are residential streets, near a primary school and a college. The racing occurs sometimes at lunchtime – especially on Sutton Way, but can also be a circuit on London Rd – Wenlock Road. I have a number of reports of night time racing on Wenlock – quite late, and on occasion. Many residents think the day time racing involves college students.	Drug Dealing Drug dealing in a number of locations: Springfield Rec., the area around the footbridge between Pool Rise and Prescott Close, on Mansel Williams Way, on the corner of Primrose Drive and Sutton Lane. Occuring mostly evening to night time, but also on occasion during the day – taking cover under trees.	Parking Issues Inconsiderate and dangerous parking – leading to restricted or low visibility for motorists / pedestrians passing by, partially blocking drives, making narrow roads impassable. This leads to reduced road safety for all users and can also lead to ASB. For example, one person asked to move their car a little along because it was making it impossible for a resident to get off their drive was aggressively driven at (this was reported to police). This kind of parking is not simply illegal parking but it is specific in that road safety is impacted negatively as a result. It includes, parking on verges, across dropped kerbs, on corners and on pavements often forcing people to walk in the road. Associated with school arrival and departure times and also related to college students. A large part of the area between the college and Wenlock has prohibited parking – yellow line so students go a bit father afield.
