20/22 PRE-APPLICATION PRESENTATION

Members received a presentation from Bryan Hamilton of AHR Architecture based in Shrewsbury as part of a pre-application consultation with stakeholders in the town, including Shropshire Council's Conservation Officer and Shrewsbury Civic Society, in relation to the proposed new hotel on an existing car park on Barker Street. Members were advised that these pre-application discussions will enable the architects to consider all proposals and make design amendments as necessary.

Mr Hamilton provided detailed explanations of the architectural design and features of the proposed building and the requirement to ensure that views of existing heritage sites in the town are not obscured.

Members expressed reservations about the reduction of car parking spaces from 95 to 29 spaces and the impact of the modern building when set against the adjacent Rowley's House. Provision of 6 disabled parking bays and 15 cycle racks will be incorporated in the plans.

Members discussed the new retail units on the ground floor and the climate change facilities that need to be incorporated in the site, including solar panels and EV charging points.
