

**THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL
(VARIOUS ROADS, SHREWSBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) ORDER 2025**

Shropshire Council (hereinafter referred to as "the Council") in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1) and 2(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 18 December 2025 and may be cited as The Shropshire Council (Various Roads, Shrewsbury) (Traffic Regulation) Order 2025.
2. The Orders listed in the Schedule to this Order are hereby revoked.
3. The County Council of Shropshire (Various Roads, Shrewsbury) (Box Junctions) Order 1982 is hereby amended by the deletion of items 1, 2, 3, and 4 from the Schedule to that Order.
4. The Shropshire Council (One-Way Streets) (Shrewsbury) Order 2012 is hereby amended by:
 - i. the deletion of the Chester Street row from the table in Schedule 2;
 - ii. the addition of the words "Pedal Cycles" to column 3 in the Castle Foregate row of the table in Schedule 2.
5. Save as provided in Article 7, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle proceeding in an easterly direction in Cross Street, Shrewsbury to make a right turn into Castle Foregate.
6. Save as provided in Article 7, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter Castle Gates from the southern access of the Shrewsbury railway station forecourt, with the exception of buses.
7. Nothing in Articles 5 or 6 of this Order shall make it unlawful to use, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in the said lengths of roads referred to in those Articles if the vehicle is, or is being used:
 - a) in connection with the carrying out on, or on premises situated on or adjacent to the said length of road of any of the following operations, namely:
 - i) the removal of any obstruction to traffic;
 - ii) the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction of the said length of road;
 - iii) the laying, erection, alteration or repair in, or in land adjacent to the said length of road, of any sewer or of any main, pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water, electricity or of any telecommunications apparatus as defined in paragraph 1(1) of the Telecommunications Code contained in Schedule 2 of the Telecommunications Act 1984;
 - b) in an emergency for fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
 - c) in the service of a local authority, or a water undertaker or sewerage undertaker, or the Environment Agency in pursuance of statutory powers or duties;

8. The prohibitions and restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.

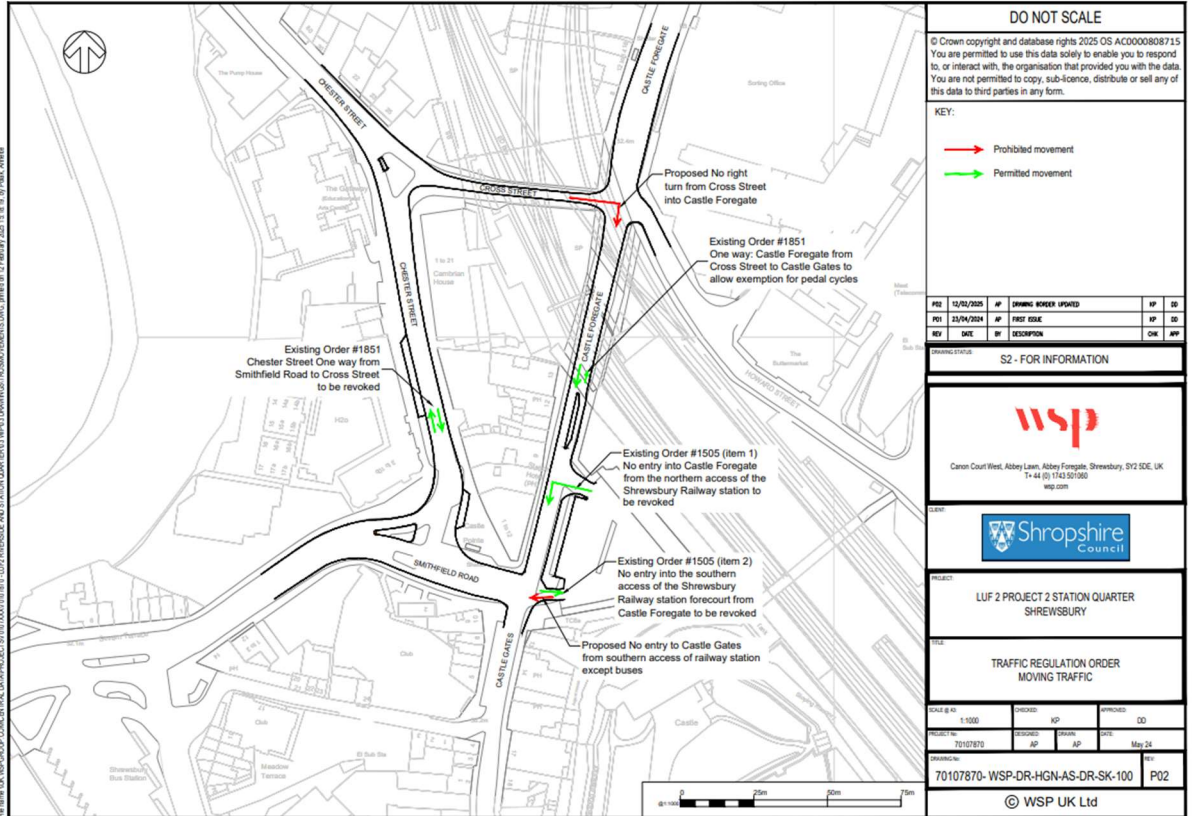
