Any existing restrictions at the above locations are revoked.

The Order will come into effect on 20 May 2023, and makes permanent the restrictions referred to above which have been in operation on an experimental basis since 20 November 2021.

A copy of the order may be examined during normal office hours (8:45am-5:00pm Monday to Thursday, and 8:45am-4:00pm on Fridays) at Shropshire Council, The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury SY2 6ND.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or any provisions in it, on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by The Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within six weeks from 16 May 2023, apply for that purpose to the High Court.
