SYT has developed a reputation for focussing on high quality drama workshops and engaging and innovative productions, predominantly of classical plays. It is the only Youth Theatre in the county to offer this opportunity.

SYT supports young people from all backgrounds in high quality drama and performing tuition. Over the years, SYT has developed a reputation for focussing on high quality drama workshops, producing engaging and innovative annual productions, predominantly of classical plays at Theatre Severn in Shrewsbury. It is the only Youth Theatre in the County to offer this opportunity.

SYT is managed by a student committee, elected annually, to determine policy, select repertoire, source funding, assist in the promotion and marketing of productions.

SYT comprises two groups – Juniors (7–13 years) and Seniors (14–25 years). Students pay fees for each term and some members receive discounts if they come from financially challenged backgrounds or if there is more than one family member attending. There are currently 32 senior members and 24 Juniors paying a fee each term.

SYT also supports the local community by performing at events such as Britain In Bloom, Bookfest, Kids Festival, and Cartoon Festival. There are opportunities for young people to engage in discussions and conferences on themes that directly affect them. Many of our members have been part of Young Peoples Arts Consortium, Local Youth Council and at National Youth Parliament events. SYT helps young people connect further across their communities through performance practice

Over the years SYT has received funding from Arts Council, Local Government Support, Private sponsorship and LJC Grant funding. We also benefit from donations from local community pots in supermarkets. We have occasionally received funding from local charity schemes.

We have been fortunate to find regular funding from a few local businesses to support our annual production in the Walker Theatre with the senior group, giving them a professionally led experience.

SYT 25 is special year for lots of young people from the past, present and future in our local community. 25 years to celebrate. Preparing for the exhibition will give the young people involved a new experience to add to their skills and achievements.

SYT would like to celebrate its 25th year with an exhibition and a documentary film of the work of Shropshire Youth Theatre. The project will be curated by a sub-committee of current students to celebrate the 25th anniversary of the formation of our youth theatre.

SYT25 the exhibition, will comprise of photographs, documentation and costumes from our archives, as well as memories and anecdotes from SYT alumni over the

course of our 25 year history. We will also be hosting a celebratory launch event for the exhibition, featuring performances and talks by current and graduated students. The exhibition will run throughout July at The Hive Gallery in Shrewsbury and will be on display to members of the public.

SYT25 Documentary film.

The film will include interviews with the founder of the Youth Theatre, quotes from members from the 25 years, some workshop examples. Students will devise a jingle to turn this documentary into a short film for legacy online status.
