## NOTICE OF CONFIRMATION OF MODIFICATION ORDER

## WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT OF RIGHTS OF WAY FOR SHROPSHIRE

## THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH ADDITION, TOWN OF SHREWSBURY) MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

On 6th February 2020 the Shropshire Council ("the Council") confirmed the above named Order to which no objections had been received.

The effect of the Order as confirmed is to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by:-

adding a footpath from point A on the order map (SJ 5098 1517) where it leaves the County Road known as Roselyn and runs in a general south easterly direction along an alleyway between numbers 32 and 34 Roselyn for approximately 45 metres and then turns to run in a general east-south-easterly direction continuing along the alleyway between numbers 73 and 75 Corndon Crescent for a further 42 metres approximately to exit on the County Road known as Corndon Crescent at point B on the order map (SJ 5106 1512); a total distance of approximately 87 metres with a width of 1.5 metres at point A on the order map, a width of 0.9 metres at point B on the order map and a width of 1.4 metres between point A and point B on the order Map.

Copies of the Order and map may be bought from the Council at the above address at a cost of £6.50 The Order becomes operative as from 6<sup>th</sup> February 2020, but if a person aggrieved by the Order desires to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of Section 53 or 54 or that any of the requirements of Schedule 15 have not been complied with in relation to the Order he may, under paragraph 12 of Schedule 15, within 42 days from the date of publication of the notice make an application to the High Court.
