DEVELOPMENT SITE Millar Homes 175 Plots, Oteley Road, Shrewsbury,
LOCATION: Shropshire

The Street Naming and Numbering Department would like to propose that the new streets are named after fallen soldiers from the First World War who were employed by the GWR (Great Western Railway) and are named on the War Memorial at Shrewsbury Station. The Severn Valley branch of the GWR historically ran through this development site and this continues with the existing theme of the street names for phase 1.

FARR (Farr Close)

JamesWilliam

Private384419, 2/7th Battalion, King's (Liverpool Regiment). Killed inaction France and Flanders 30th October 1917. Aged 19. Son of Jessie& Georgina Farr, of Greenfield's, Watling Street, Craven Arms, Shropshire. Employed at Bromborough as a Booking Clerk. No known grave. Commemoratedon TYNE COT MEMORIAL, Zonnebeke, Belgium. Panel 31 to 34 & 162 &162A & 163A.

GWILT (Gwilt Drive)

ThomasFrederick

Private57567, 2nd Battalion, Lincolnshire Regiment. Killed in action Franceand Flanders 27th May 1918. Aged 19. Born Montgomery. Son of Herbert& Sarah Gwilt, of Sascott, Ford, Shropshire. No known grave. Commemoratedon SOISSONS MEMORIAL, Aisne, France

GREEN (Green Crescent)

JamesH

Private33148, 6th Battalion, Kings Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed inaction France and Flanders 16th August 1917. Aged 19. Born Ludlow, Shropshire, Son of George & Mary A. Green, of Maryvale Cottage, Lower Mill, Street, Ludlow. Employed at Ludlow as a Shunter. Noknown grave. Commemorated on TYNE COT MEMORIAL, Zonnebeke, Belgium, Panel 112 to 113.

TIPTON (Tipton Close)

Bert

Private33153, 6th Battalion, Kings Shropshire Light Infantry. Killed inaction France and Flanders 20th September 1917. Aged 20. Born Hadley, Shropshire, Brother of Harry Tipton, of 7, Bridge Street, Normanton, Yorkshire, enlisted Wellington, Salop. Employed at Wellington. Noknown grave. Commemorated on TYNE COT MEMORIAL, Zonnebeke, Belgium. Panel 112 to 113
