Annexes

Annex 1 - Mandatory Conditions

For the supply of alcohol

No supply of alcohol may be made under the premises licence -

- (a) at a time when there is no designated premises supervisor in respect of the premises licence, or
- (b) at a time when the designated premises supervisor does not hold a personal licence or their personal licence is suspended.

Every supply of alcohol under the premises licence must be made or authorised by a person who holds a personal licence.

Exhibition of films

For all premises licences and club premises certificate authorising the exhibition of films, access will be restricted only to those who meet the required age limit in line with any certificate granted by the British Board of Film Classification.

Admission of children to the exhibition of any film to be restricted in accordance with the recommendations given to films by a body designated under Section 4 of the Video Recordings Act 1984 - the British Board of Film Classification is the only body so designated.

Door Supervision

Where a premises licence includes a condition that at specified times one or more individuals must be at the premises to carry out a security activity, each such individual must be licensed by the Security Industry Authority.

Mandatory Drinks Code Conditions

1. The responsible person shall take all reasonable steps to ensure that staff do not carry out, arrange or participate in any irresponsible promotions in relation to the premises. An irresponsible promotion means any one or more of the following activities, or substantially similar activities, carried on for the purpose of encouraging the sale or supply of alcohol for consumption on the premises in a manner which carries a significant risk of leading or contributing to crime and disorder, prejudice to public safety, public nuisance, or harm to children:

(a) games or other activities which require or encourage, or are designed to require or encourage, individuals to:

- (i) drink a quantity of alcohol within a time limit (other than to drink alcohol sold or supplied on the premises before the cessation of the period in which the responsible person is authorised to sell or supply alcohol), or
- (ii) drink as much alcohol as possible (whether within a time limit or otherwise);

(b) provision of unlimited or unspecified quantities of alcohol free or for a fixed or discounted fee to the public or to a group defined by a particular characteristic (other than any promotion or discount available to an individual in respect of alcohol for consumption at a

table meal, as defined in section 159 of the Act);

(c) provision of free or discounted alcohol or any other thing as a prize to encourage or reward the purchase and consumption of alcohol over a period of 24 hours or less;

(d) provision of free or discounted alcohol in relation to the viewing on the premises of a sporting event, where that provision is dependent on:

- (i) the outcome of a race, competition or other event or process, or
- (ii) the likelihood of anything occurring or not occurring;

(e) selling or supplying alcohol in association with promotional posters or flyers on, or in the vicinity of, the premises which can reasonably be considered to condone, encourage or glamorise anti-social behaviour or to refer to the effects of drunkenness in any favourable manner.

2. The responsible person shall ensure that no alcohol is dispensed directly by one person into the mouth of another (other than where that other person is unable to drink without assistance by reason of a disability).

3. The responsible person shall ensure that free tap water is provided on request to customers where it is reasonably available.

4. (i) The premises licence holder or club premises certificate holder shall ensure that an age verification policy applies to the premises in relation to the sale or supply of alcohol.

(ii) The policy must require individuals who appear to the responsible person to be under 18 years of age (or such older age as may be specified in the policy) to produce on request, before being served alcohol, identification bearing their photograph, date of birth and a holographic mark.

5. The responsible person shall ensure that:

(a) where any of the following alcoholic drinks is sold or supplied for consumption on the premises (other than alcoholic drinks sold or supplied having been made up in advance ready for sale or supply in a securely closed container) it is available to customers in the following measures:

- (i) beer or cider: 1/2 pint;
- (ii) gin, rum, vodka or whisky: 25 ml or 35 ml; and
- (iii) still wine in a glass: 125 ml; and

(b) customers are made aware of the availability of these measures.

Annex 2 - Conditions consistent with the operating schedule

Prevention of Crime & Disorder

The premises would be a member of Shopwatch / Pubwatch;
Any organisation seeking to hire the premises for an event including the sale of alcohol would be required to have nominated a personal licence holder;
Event marshals would be employed where appropriate;
SIA registered security personnel would be employed at the Proms Concerts and the Folk Festival event which would form part of the Summer Season.

Public Safety

The premises schedule of conditions and local agreements would be adhered to;
A risk assessment would be carried out when required;
The number of people attending events would be controlled;
There would be first aid facilities / responders on site;
All temporary structures, including lighting towers and stages, must be checked, inspected and certified by a competent person (e.g. an Associate Member of the Institute of Structural Engineers) before use to ensure that they are safe;
Electrical equipment brought onto site must be tested for electrical safety and a certificate provided to the Licensing Authority;
All cables should be routed or covered so as not to cause a tripping hazard;
Health and Safety Risk Assessments (and supporting documentation) approved by the Health & Safety Executive, Police and Fire Authority must be adhered to at all times.

Prevention of Public Nuisance

Additional toilet facilities would be provided;
There would be compliance with the policies of the Council;
Regulated Entertainment shall finish no later than 23:30 hours and the site shall be cleared of members of the public by 00:00 hours, except for those camping with the authority of the Council in specially designated areas and complying with the conditions imposed by the Council for that purpose;
A maximum of ten 'outdoor' Music Events shall be held per year. All precautions shall be undertaken to ensure that local residents will not be unreasonably disturbed during the events;
In the case of all events, compliance with the licensing objectives will be achieved by adhering to the schedule of conditions and local agreements developed for each specific event in consultation and agreement with the Licensing Authority, Statutory Consultees and relevant officers of the Councils;
All requirements contained in the "Policy for Firework Displays on Land Owned by the Council", together with any revision agreed by the Licensing Authority and Statutory Consultees, shall be met.

Protection of Children

Shrewsbury Leisure's Child Protection Policies would be adhered to;
There would be no sales of alcohol to anyone under the age of 18 years;
There would be a proof of age scheme in operation with a passport or driving licence accepted as identification;
There would be adequate insurance cover for events at which children

would be present;
Certificates of structural worthiness would be required for Fun Fairs.

Annex 3 - Conditions attached after a hearing by the Licensing Authority

That on occasions where the Regulated Entertainment ceases prior to 23:00 hours, the Sale of Alcohol shall cease at the same time as the end of the Regulated Entertainment and the premises shall be cleared of members of the public 30 minutes after the end of the Regulated Entertainment except, for those camping with the authority of the Council in specially designated areas and complying with the conditions imposed by the Borough Council for that purpose.
