


**Main Areas:** Upton Lane, Monkmoor Rec, The Quarry, Town, Sundorne and Lantern, Meole Estate and Macdonald's/Sainsbury's, Castlefields and Ditherington, Column, Burrs Field.

**Other places visited**: St Giles and around Frankwell Cricket Ground, Kynaston, Canal footpath and woodland behind Sundorne Sports Village, Meole Village and school playing field, Greenfields, Belle Vue Youth Centre and behind Nando's Tankerville Street, Castle walk and Weir, Doctor's Field.

We have been working with 5 groups on a regular basis.

We have found there is a lot of crossover, young people are willing to cross boundaries and territories to meet with friends or school mates. Schools' intakes are across Shrewsbury so young people are mixing more.

**Issues raised**: Labelling, drugs, school, bullying, police, transgender, behaviour/additional needs, projects/activities.
