### THE SHROPSHIRE COUNCIL (FOOTPATH 14Y (PART), TOWN OF SHREWSBURY AND FOOTPATHS 13 AND 14, PARISH OF ASTLEY AND FOOTPATH 14 (PART), PARISH OF UFFINGTON) PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION ORDER 2016

The above named order made on 14<sup>th</sup> January 2016 by the Shropshire Council ("the Council") under section 119 of the Highways Act 1980, will **divert** 

The full width of that part of Footpath 14Y Shrewsbury from point A on the order map (SJ 5221 1625) where there is an existing pedestrian gate, running generally easterly across a pasture field for approximately 135 metres to the parish boundary at point B (SJ 5234 1623), then crossing a stile and continuing as Footpath 14 Astley in a general southerly direction crossing a second stile and shortly afterwards turning generally south easterly across a pasture field for approximately 268 metres to the parish boundary and then continuing as Footpath 14 Uffington generally south easterly within woodland for a further 55 metres approximately to point D (SJ 52551599) on the order map; also Footpath 13 Astley from point C (SJ 5251 1603) on the order map running in a general south south westerly direction traversing a steep bank for approximately 45 metres to point E (SJ 52481599) on the order map where there is a pedestrian gate; a total distance of approximately 503 metres; **onto a line** 

from a pedestrian gate at point A (SJ 5221 1625), on the order map, running in a general south south easterly direction crossing a pasture field for approximately 212 metres to cross a field boundary via a pedestrian gate at point F (SJ 5232 1607) on the order map then turning to follow the southern side of a field boundary in a general east south easterly direction within a pasture field for approximately 175 metres to point E (SJ 5247 1599) on the order map at its junction with Footpath 13Y Shrewsbury where there is a pedestrian gate giving access to the continuation of the route as Footpath 14 within Uffington Parish along an unsurfaced track within woodland running in a general easterly direction for a further 75 metres approximately to point D

(SJ 52551599) on the order map and the continuation of the unaffected part of Footpath 14 Uffington; a total distance of approximately 462 metres with a width of 2 metres throughout.

A copy of the order and the order map and an explanatory statement have been placed and may be seen free of charge at the Council offices at The Shirehall, Abbey Foregate, Shrewsbury during normal office hours.
