## **Tree Preservation Order for which representations have been received. Proposed for confirmation without modification.**

The Shropshire Council (*Land at 9 Kennedy Roadl, Shrewsbury*) Tree Preservation Order 2018

- 1.0 This Tree Preservation Order (TPO) was created on 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2018. The reason for making the TPO was to preserve the amenity and character of the area by protecting trees that make a significant contribution to these attributes.
- 2.0 One representation objection to the order has been received during the consultation period.

Tree No.	Summary of Representation	Response
T1	The representation recognised that the tree contributes to the appearance and amenity of the conservation area but raises concerns that that the tree is taking resources from and casting shade over the boundary hedge and causing poor growth. The hedge is also a significant element in the landscape and amenity of the area and is important in the context of the dwelling.	<p>The tree is a significant element in the street scene, appearance and amenity of the Conservation Area.</p> <p>It is agreed that the hedge is important, however, a subsequent assessment of the hedge has indicated that the tree is not a significant factor in its reduced growth. There is also provision within the TPO to make application to work on the tree should evidence be provide that demonstrates that the tree is negatively affecting the hedge and this would then be considered on its merits.</p>
