**Allotments** – These will remain open to tenants.

Bus Shelters – These will remain usable. Any queries regarding the bus service should be made with Shropshire Council at shropshire.gov.uk/public-transport/ or via 0345 678 9006.

Parks, Gardens and Play Areas – We will continue to maintain these areas as normal and allow access to the public wherever possible. However, given the rapidly changing picture we may have to limit the services we can provide during this period.

We advise anyone using the play areas to wash your hands both directly before and after use.

Large events in public areas such as the Quarry may have to be postponed. Please refer to the organiser for more information.

Markets – Both the Market Hall and Sunday market at Battlefield will remain open for the time being. This may change following any Government directives.

**Public Conveniences** – We will continue to clean and service public conveniences as normal and allow access to the public wherever possible. However, given the rapidly changing picture we may have to limit the services we can provide during this period.

Recreational Grounds and Sports Facilities – We will continue to maintain these areas as normal and allow access to the public wherever possible. However, given the rapidly changing picture we may have to limit the services we can provide during this period.

**Youth Services** – Our services will follow schools with regards to closure of the clubs. However, should we need to close clubs or other services, we will still offer support to our members via the internet or telephone during the time slot that clubs would usually be open.
